In 1984 he moved to El Paso, Texas, part of the Texas Tech Medical Program, completed a Flexible Internship and a year of General Surgery, with specific orthopedic rotations during those two years.

Dr. Wagon finished his Orthopedic specialist training at the William Beaumont Army Medical Center – Texas Tech Orthopaedic program in 1990.
